

This Cookie Policy explains how JUGS@Malta Limited (C 29241) (the "Company", "we", "us" and "our") uses cookies when you visit our website found at the address <u>http://www.jugsmalta.com/</u> (the "Website").

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that websites place on your device as you are browsing. They are processed and stored by your web browser. Insofar as they may be used to identify an individual, cookies are considered as personal data under the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (the "GDPR").

Cookies set by the operator of this Website are called "first-party cookies", whilst cookies set by parties other than this Website operator are called "third-party cookies". We do not control the types of information processed by these third-party cookies. We encourage you to check the relevant third party's website for more information on the manner in which they use cookies.

Most browsers have cookies enabled by default. However, you are able to change your cookie settings through your web browser 'settings' menu. Note that, if you opt to block cookies, this may affect the functionality of our Website. You may also be unable to access or make use of all or parts of our Website.
